By submitting an application, applicants will agree to be bound by the following Terms and Conditions:

- All costs and charges incurred as a result of making this application cannot be claimed, whether or not the application is successful.
- All applications will be treated in the strictest confidence and will only be shared with those involved with the evaluation and the processing of your application, namely Coast to Capital Officers and Programme Committee members.
- Coast to Capital will keep a record of your contact details and application on file. Your application will remain confidential and be processed in accordance with our [Privacy Policy](#).
- All applications for funding will be reviewed and decided on the basis of written submissions only, as supplied by the applicant.
- Applicants who are unsuccessful following their submission accept that they will be informed in writing and will not receive individual feedback on their application. Information in relation to evaluation and scoring will not be published.
- That the decision of the Coast to Capital is final in deciding which applications are awarded funding, and there is no right of appeal or complaint through our formal complaints procedure. Any applications for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOI) as to the reasons for an application not being successful will be rejected.
- Applicants agree to not issue any written or verbal statements to any third party which could reasonably be seen to be designed to defame, discredit, or to undermine the decision reached by the Coast to Capital.
- Grant payment will not be made until a funding agreement is signed by both parties, and non-compliance with use of the fund as agreed will result in a funding clawback.
- A list of all successful projects and organisations will be published on the Coast to Capital website and permission may be sought for use of successful projects in promotional case studies.
