

The Five Priority Sectors

The priority sectors were identified by research commissioned by Coast to Capital as having "a clear local concentration; potential future growth opportunities; a strong presence of internationally recognised companies; a research base to support sector development within the Coast to Capital LEP; and their FDI potential, based on UKTI's priority sectors"¹. These sectors are:

- Creative, Digital, and Information Technology.
- Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering.
- Health and Life Sciences.
- Environmental Technology and Low Carbon and Environmental Goods and Services.
- Financial and Business Services.

Environmental Technology and Low Carbon and Environmental Goods and Services:

There is currently no official, measurable classification for this sector, through SIC's or other means, partially due to the market being in its early stages and companies involved cut across sectors. However, due to the attention being given to this sector, the importance and support given to it by government, and increasing market activity and maturity, it is likely it will reach a critical mass where it can no longer be without official classification. In the interim a solution for measuring this industry is likely to be found using third party research and market intelligence reports, however this requires further work.
